#### Workshop March 28- 29, 2008 - Fürstenfeld

In preparation for our first publication a workshop will be held from March 28-29, 2008 at ZIS-FF in Fürstenfeld. Internal Members have committed themselves to participate and we hope that all of them are able to attend. External Members are invited and most welcome to participate.

The European Network for the Study of Globalization (ENG), hosted by the Center for Intercultural Studies in Fürstenfeld (ZIS-FF), organizes a workshop from March 28-29 in Fürstenfeld.

As organizational issues took up the constitutive meeting in May 2007, this workshop will be the platform to launch the collective work of the group on the globalization issue. It will also serve as the yearly meeting of ENG-network.

Following the principles established at the first meeting, the internal members of the group will participate in person and provide directly their input to the discussion. External members of the network are invited to participate at their own expenses and/or to follow the debate on the Internet platform, where papers and comments can be uploaded easily.

In their papers, the members of the network present the results of their empirical studies in order to foster a theoretical debate within the group. The readiness to engage in theoretical reflections on the basis of sound empirical research is a key feature of this group and will provide new insights into the different aspects of the process of globalization, which is still in want for a comprehensive assessment.

The organizers of the workshop are committed to prepare a publication to be issued in fall 2008, as agreed in the work plan of 2007. The results of the discussions will help to further develop the concepts of the 'second generation' of globalization research.
